Eli Chesen, M.D.

Eli S. Chesen, M.D. grew up in Sioux City, IA and earned his B.S. and M.D. degrees at the University of Nebraska College of Medicine with residency training at Good Samaritan Hospital in Phoenix. He served in the Air Force where he held the rank of Major and was the Chief of Psychiatry at Nellis Air Force Base, Nevada prior to going into his Lincoln private practice.

He serves as a "Board Examiner," evaluating other psychiatrists for their Board Certification and he is a "Distinguished Life Fellow" in The American Psychiatric Association.

Chesen authored the popular book: *President Nixon's Psychiatric Profile* and served as an advisor for the 1977 *Frost-Nixon Interviews* helping to craft the questions which were asked of the former President. Chesen has written for *The New York Times Sunday Magazine*, has been featured in *Popular Science* and *Newsweek* appeared on *Donahue*, *Regis*, *Good Morning America* and *The CBS Evening News*. His book led to a cover story in *Parade Magazine*.

Chesen is an inventor and received a \$10,000 grant from the Department of Energy and recognition from *Popular Science* for his green, refrigerant-mediated swimming pool heater.
